**PINOT NOIR 2005
CARGASACCHI-JALAMA VINEYARD
POTBELLY BLOCK
SANTA BARBARA COUNTY**

This vineyard site is located just outside the Santa Rita Hills appellation on the western side closer to the ocean. During the Fall of 2000, Peter Cargasacchi asked if I would be interested in a custom planting of 1.5 acres on his families' Jalama Ranch. This 2005 vintage Pinot Noir is the inaugural release from this special property.

Deep red cherry color. The nose is exotic and complex with spicy plum blossoms, pomegranates and Bing cherries. The palate is soft and easy flowing which cascades with mouth watering red fruits and consistent mineral tones on the finish. A wonderful and elegant balance between fruit weight, tannin and acidity.
