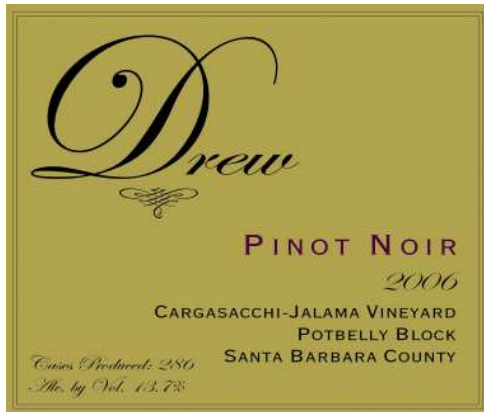




**2006 PINOT NOIR
CARGASACCHI- JALAMA VINEYARD
'Potbelly Block'
SANTA BARBARA COUNTY**



In my opinion, this is a very well proportioned wine. The color is a nice dark cherry red reaching to garnet hues. The nose has a spicy, clean black cherry quality with a wonderful tight grain oak nuance in the background. Compared to last year, the wine excels in both depth and richness. This wine is seductive and elegant in taste with fresh blackberry, pomegranates and cherry pie with charm to boot. Excellent! This vineyard site is located outside the Santa Rita Hills appellation on the west side, closest to the ocean than any other in Sta. Rita Hills. This young vineyard was established in 2000 and the 1.5 acre Potbelly section was custom planted specifically for Drew. The 06 is the second, single vineyard Cargasacchi-Jalama Vineyard for Drew and already has developed an undeniably distinctive quality. Enjoy!
